### 2017-2018 Fulbright-Nehru International Education Administrators Seminar

The Fulbright-Nehru International Education Administrators Seminar (IEAS) aims to provide Indian college and university administrators the opportunity to familiarize themselves with the U.S. higher education system.

The two-week U.S. visit in October 2017 will enable participants to learn about various facets of U.S. higher education, including the types of institutions, accreditation, curriculum development, fund-raising, student services and international education on U.S. campuses, as well as share knowledge on Indian higher education. Topics addressed during visits and meetings at select campuses and organizations will also include research collaborations, faculty and student exchanges, and study abroad.

This seminar is designed for Indian college and university administrators with at least two years of experience in international program development and management at their institutions in India. Applicants must be middle to senior-level college or university administrators (deans, department heads, directors of international centres or offices, foreign student advisors, registrars etc.) who have substantial responsibility for enhancing the international dimension of their institutions and who wish to build capacity of their faculty and students through international collaborations and exchange and innovative curricular design.

#### Grant Benefits

Selected participants will receive round-trip economy class air travel from India to the U.S., travel within the U.S., lodging and a per-diem. Grantee spouses and dependents are not allowed to accompany during the seminar.

## UNITED STATES-INDIA EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION (USIEF) 2018-2019 Fulbright-Nehru and other Fulbright Fellowships for Indian Citizens

### Fulbright-Nehru Master's Fellowships

These fellowships are for outstanding Indians who demonstrate leadership qualities, have completed the equivalent of a U.S. bachelor's degree, and have at least three years of professional work experience, to pursue a master's degree program at selected U.S. colleges and universities in the areas of Arts and Culture Management including Heritage Conservation and Museum Studies; Environmental Science/Studies; Higher Education Administration; International Legal Studies; Public Administration; Public Health; Urban and Regional Planning; and Women's Studies/Gender Studies.

**Application deadline: June 15, 2017**

### Fulbright-Nehru Doctoral Research Fellowships\*

These pre-doctoral level research fellowships, for six to nine months, are designed for Indian scholars who are registered for a Ph.D. at an Indian institution.

**Application deadline: June 15, 2017**

### Fulbright-Nehru Postdoctoral Research Fellowships\*

These fellowships, for eight to 24 months, are designed for Indian faculty and researchers residing in India, who have a Ph.D. degree within the past four years.

**Application deadline: July 17, 2017**

#### \*Eligible Fields of Study

Agricultural Sciences; Bioengineering; Computer Science (with emphasis on cyber security and digital economy); Economics; Education Policy and Planning; Energy Studies; International Law; International Security and Strategic Studies; Materials Science (with emphasis on environmental applications); Neurosciences; Public Health; Public Policy; Study of India (limited to anthropology, history, sociology, and visual and performing arts); Study of the U.S. (limited to anthropology, history, sociology, and visual and performing arts); Urban and Regional Planning (with emphasis on smart cities and waste management); and Women's and Gender Studies.

(Note: In addition to above mentioned fields, Climate Change Sciences is offered for Fulbright-Nehru Academic and Professional Excellence Fellowships only.)

### Fulbright-Nehru Academic and Professional Excellence Fellowships\*

These fellowships, for four to nine months, aim to provide Indian faculty, researchers, and professionals residing in India the opportunity to teach, conduct research, or carry out a combination of lecturing and research at a U.S. institution. Applicants can opt for four to six-month Flex Awards in two segments.

**Application deadline: July 17, 2017**

### Fulbright-Kalam Climate Fellowship

These fellowships aim at building long-term capacity in the U.S. and India by engaging scientific and technical research scholars and professionals related to climate research and education.

- Indian students registered for a Ph.D. at an Indian institution can apply for six to nine months pre-doctoral level research in the U.S.
- Indian faculty and researchers who have a Ph.D. degree within the past four years can apply for eight to 12 months postdoctoral research in the U.S.

### Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program

For young and mid-career professionals, policy makers, planners, administrators, and managers in the government, public and private sectors, and NGOs for professional development in the fields of Agricultural and Rural Development; Communications/Journalism; Economic Development; Educational Administration, Planning and Policy; Finance and Banking; Higher Education Administration; HIV/AIDS Policy and Prevention; Human Resource Management; Law and Human Rights; Natural Resources, Environmental Policy, and Climate Change; Public Health Policy and Management; Public Policy Analysis and Public Administration; Substance Abuse Education, Treatment and Prevention; Teaching of English as a Foreign Language (Teacher Training or Curriculum Development); Technology Policy and Management; Trafficking in Persons, Policy and Prevention; Urban and Regional Planning.
