

ABOUT BHASHA SANSKRUTI MANDIR

Bhasha Sanskruti Mandir is a unit of Gujarat Vidyapith, Ahmedabad, established in 1990 through the visionary efforts of then Vice Chancellor Prof. Ramlal Parikh. Rooted in the Gandhian belief that the soul of India resides in its languages, the Mandir brings a wide spectrum of Bharatiya and international languages together under one roof — teaching, researching, and celebrating them not as isolated subjects but as living carriers of culture, identity, and collective consciousness. Gujarat Vidyapith itself was founded by Mahatma Gandhi in 1920 as a national institution rooted in Swadeshi, Satyagraha, and Sarvodaya, and has held Deemed-to-be-University status from the UGC since 1963. Guided today by Chancellor Acharya Devvrat ji (Hon'ble Governor of Gujarat) and Vice Chancellor Dr. Harshad Patel, the institute continues Gandhiji's vision of education for the head, hand, and heart.
